Communication in Autism Parent Coaching Program, *an invitation to participate in [research study](#)*

The goal of this study is to test a new program called Communication in Autism Parent Coaching Program. The program aims to teach parents of children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) how to build their children's language and communication skills.



The Facts:

- Approximately 25% of children with ASD do not use language to communicate
- Children with ASD who struggle to communicate are more at risk to show challenging behaviors
- The Communication in Autism Parent Coaching Program developed at the AJ Drexel Autism Institute uses evidence-based strategies to teach communication and language to children with ASD

If you have a child with ASD who has minimal or no verbal communication between 24 and 72 months, you might be eligible to participate in the study

Benefits to you:

- Includes a no-cost evaluation of your child's communication & other functional skills
- Opportunity to receive the Communication in Autism Parent Coaching Program at no cost
 - Sessions may be in-person, by telehealth, or a combination
- Participants will be compensated for their time
